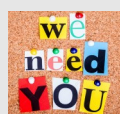

Head lice

We have had quite a few severe cases of head lice recently. Can we ask you to please keep checking your child's hair. The best way is to use the comb after every wash to ensure no eggs have been missed as they quickly spread again. The NHS recommend combing daily for at least 2 weeks. There is no reason to keep children off school if they have head lice. Thank you.
