We are once again delighted that we will be able to welcome all children back to school on **Monday 8th March**.

We are looking to operate school procedures in the same way we did last September and throughout the Autumn Term.

At Charnwood, your child's safety and well-being are paramount and we will continue to follow all the guidance set out by The Government.

Below is a list of key points as a reminder with a few changes:

Attendance is mandatory for all children and non-attendance will be tracked as usual with the possibility of fining.

Staggered opening times

Start time of 8.45am for Year 6 and Year 5 plus siblings

Start time of 8.55am for Year 4, Year 3 and Year 2 plus siblings

Start time of 9.00am for Year 1, Reception and Nursery

Gate will be closed at 9.05am prompt.

Staggered finishing times

3pm for Nursery, Reception and Year 1

3.10pm for Year 2

3.15pm for Year 3 and Year 4

3.20pm for Year 5 and Year 6

- ◆ We encourage children in years 4, 5 and 6 to enter and leave the school site independently. If dropping them off outside of school, please choose a safe location to do so.

- ◆ PE kit to be worn on PE days - see information sent by class teachers.
- ◆ Only bring essential items into school e.g. coat, water bottle, sun cream if required, reading book and a packed lunch should you wish. Please do not bring any other items into school e.g. toys. School will provide all resources including pencil case items although your child may bring a wipeable pencil case.
- ◆ Please continue to use our wrap around care which remains open. Breakfast Club provision starts at 7.45am daily and After School Club runs until 5.30pm
- ◆ Absence: Please ring school on 01543 227560 and leave a message on the absence line on the first day of absence with a full description. There is no need to talk directly to a member of staff unless it is urgent. Please do not use Dojo to inform us.
- ◆ We will continue to support all children in their learning and will provide extra support where possible.
- ◆ We will continue to use Class Dojo to communicate and provide ideas for you to support children in working towards their personal targets.
