



Dear Parents/Carers

Traffic on site

Following recent Health and Safety information and input, we continue to have serious concerns around the transport coming onto the campus for Charnwood Primary Academy and Rocklands School.

As you will be aware, there is a lot of transport coming onto the site at certain times of the day. Although pick up and drop off times have been staggered as much as possible to alleviate a lot of issues, and a lot of the problems are managed appropriately, **there is still a very strong possibility that there will be a serious incident if further measures aren't put in place.**

Difficulties have been observed to be coming from parents coming onto the site, sometimes at speed, and parking inappropriately. This was observed to be parents of children at both Rocklands and Charnwood. **The speed limit on site is 5mph for the safety of everyone.**

From **Monday 2nd March 2020**, Parents/carers without 'blue badges' will be asked to park off site at all times. We will also be installing two additional CCTV cameras that will cover the whole of the campus area. This will ensure all traffic on and off the site can be monitored.

The following arrangements will continue:

08:40 – 09:05, parents/carers transporting their own children will not be allowed on site, to reduce hazards and congestion. This is the time when buses and taxis will arrive and drop off. There will be no change for those parents that drop their children off before 08:30.

We would also again remind parents/ carers not to arrive on school site before 2:40 in the afternoons. Buses and taxis have been asked not to arrive on site before 3:10 pm.

There have also been difficulties caused by parents/carers parking outside the marked bays. This creates difficulties for other vehicles and emergency access. We will ask any parents parking inappropriately to move their cars to a marked bay or off site if the car park is full.

If parents do require site access at other times, this must be pre-arranged with school.



We do hope that you understand the reason for these measures. **The safety of your children is our prime concern at all times.**
