## English

- We will read Leon and the Place Between by Angela McAllister and create our own version of a fantasy narrative.
- We will use the co-ordinating conjunctions and subordinating conjunctions when, if, because and although.
- We will read Cloud Tea Monkeys by Mal Peet and use what we have learnt to write a non-Chronological Report
- We will write a recount of our visit to Lichfield Cathedral.
